WALGREENS – REDI PROGRAM ALEX MALDONADO



Determined and hard-working, Alex Maldonado joined the Walgreens REDI program. REDI is a 4-5 week, in-store retail and customer service skills training program. The program is designed for Walgreen's store managers to train registered community agency Job Coaches. Job Coaches then train the REDI externs using the REDI curriculum. REDI training covers competencies such as how to unload trucks, stock shelves, run a cash register, etc. Upon completion, REDI graduates are welcome to apply for positions within Walgreens.

Alex was warmly welcomed to the REDI Program at his local Walgreens store in the Plant City area by his manager, Matt. With the assistance of his Job Coach, Damaris Rosales, Alex eagerly started his training and did an outstanding job learning all the tasks of the Customer Service Associate. Alex graduated from the program and applied for a permanent position, in which he was immediately hired and has been working there since, doing a great job!

Since the program launched in 2012, more than 1,300 people with disabilities have completed REDI skills training in Walgreens stores across the nation. In the process, REDI participants have gained new skills and confidence. REDI graduates have told Walgreens the experience enabled them to build lives that otherwise might not have been possible simply because opportunities were not presented to them. ## JUMP ON BOARD - TIPS TO HELP REACH YOUR DESTINATION

#### BEFORE THE SEARCH

Finding the right job can be difficult, but one surprising step can make the process a lot easier. Ask yourself, what kind of job am I looking for? Finding a job that fits YOU is a bigger undertaking than simply applying to as many jobs as possible. Below is a guide to help you visualize what the right job for you looks like.

Environment - Do you prefer to stand and walk around often, or do you focus better sat at a desk? Does your workstation need to be quiet, or do you work well with on-going noise? Would you perform better while working at home, or do you thrive when you have a building to call a workplace?

Pace - Are you typically laid back and prefer work that comes as it needs to be done? Or do you prefer to be proactive and constantly busy?

Managerial - Do you need someone who is always on top of what you do? Or are you very independent, only needing to speak to a higher-up when absolutely necessary? What is the best way for a higher-up to let you know you have done well?
