Once you go through VR and pick an Employment Services Provider, you may be wondering, what is next? When selecting The Vocation Depot, we will assign you an Employment Specialist within your area. It is essential that you have a good rapport with your Employment Specialist as they, and your VRC, will be your main points of contact while job searching. So what does an Employment Specialist do? Depending on your needs they offer a range of helpful services such as resume writing, mock interviews, job searching, and job applications. An employment Specialist can even help with accommodations or help you disclose your disability if you choose to do so. The best results are seen in cases where the Employment Specialist, and Client, are applying to jobs and job searching, so all of our Specialists teach the skills needed to successfully find the right job, while also undertaking the search themselves. After the right job is found, they also provide follow-up services to make sure the job is a good fit. They can help mediate issues on the job, or bring up any concerns you might have to the manager in an effort to resolve them. The goal of the Employment Specialist is to find you meaningful, successful work.

Tony Farinella is the co-founder and CEO of The Vocation Depot. His desire to help others has been at the forefront of his career. In addition, he most recently served as Regional Vice President for the East Region, Sunbelt Division for Signature Health Care prior to joining Premier Workforce Solutions as their COO.

Prior to joining Signature Healthcare, he held the position of Director of Transitional Care & Physician Services for Gulf Coast Health Care for 5 years. He supported 44 Skilled Nursing and Rehabilitation Centers in Alabama, Florida, and Mississippi. His primary focus included analyzing local markets and developing post-acute care strategies with physicians, hospitals, managed care, and APM's. He leads the organization in teaching and understanding the changes that were occurring in the long-term care sector. In addition, he was the lead for GCHC's telehealth initiatives and supported the organization's development of four new communities. For most of his 25-year career in health care, he has been the administrator and senior administrator of various Skilled Nursing centers in south Florida, responsible for daily operations. These responsibilities included clinical care, regulatory compliance, human resources, fiduciary responsibilities, and many others. He has also served as an adjunct professor at Florida International University.

Tony possesses a Bachelor's and master's degree in health services administration. He is also a graduate of Dale Carnegie Training. In addition, he served in the United States Army and National Guard for six years, where he received numerous Meritorious Achievement Medals, along with a Good Conduct Medal. In 2010, he was recognized by the American College of Health Care Administrators as a leader in quality performance in the long-term care field. He is also an alumnus of the Florida Health Care Association's 2012 Leadership Program. Mr. Farinella also served on the Board for the Florida Licensed Professional Nurse Association and has been a guest speaker at the National Association of Professional Nurse Educators, local AARP Chapter, and the Dade County Health Symposium.

He has been an advocate for the elderly and disabled for the past 25 years. He was recognized by the State Attorney's Office for his dedication and service. He is also a proud father of two amazing children Marisa & Carson.

Since 1925, Florida Department of Education, Division of Vocational Rehabilitation (VR) is the state agency that helps people with physical and mental disabilities prepare for, get, advance in or keep a job.

Who can use The Vocation Depot?

The Vocation Depot is open to everyone who goes through the Florida State VR or Ticket to Work system to receive services. Regardless of disability, age, race, gender, sexual orientation, or previous charges; we help anyone who is ready to work.

Does The Vocation Depot have a specialty?

The Vocation Depot strives to help anyone ready to work, but we do have strong connections and resources for Veterans and current Service Members. The Vocation Depot is a Disabled Veteran Operated Entity, and we have been awarded the HireVets award by the Department of Labor. We understand the difficulties Veterans and Service Members face when returning to the workforce, especially when returning with PTSD or other service-related disabilities. From Pre-Employment Training, which helps prepare one with skills for the workforce, to On the Job Training opportunities, which is paid work on a trial level to see which job is the right fit, we can make sure you feel secure when finding a job.

How do you pick The Vocation Depot as your service provider?

The Florida State VR and Ticket to Work system work on a customer's choice basis. For VR, just tell your VR Counselor which provider you would like your referral assigned to, ie. The Vocation Depot. For Ticket to Work, please call us for intake, 888-489-6466, and we can assign your ticket if you decide we feel like a comfortable fit.
