WHAT IS OJT?

OJT is an On The Job Training Opportunity, where an Employer mentors a person with a disability to help them develop skills in the workplace. OJT is very beneficial for those who have never had a job or for someone who has a large gap between employment as it is work experience you are able to put on your resume. OJT is a fully paid position; you are guaranteed to make at least minimum wage, and you can work as many hours as you would like up to a maximum of 40 hours per week. An OJT experience can also be for youth customers under the age of 21 who are still in school; it is then called WBLE or a Work-Based Learning Experience.

The Vocation Depot is partnered with the Walgreens REDI (Retail Employees with Disabilities Initiative) program, meaning we can quickly place someone in an OJT at Walgreens locations throughout Florida. We also have many connections within the community, which will help us find a perfect fit for your job goal. You will be paid on a bi-weekly basis and always have the support of your Employment Specialist as well. OJT is also a great way to experience a job before deciding if that career path or job goal is right for you. If you are interested in participating in an OJT, please talk with your Voc Rehab Counselor or your Employment Specialist so that we can help you find an OJT that is right for you.

The Vocation Depot is available to anyone who goes through the State of Florida Vocational Rehabilitation program or through the Social Security Administration via the Ticket to Work program to receive Employment services. Regardless of disability, age, race, gender, sexual orientation, or previous charges; we help anyone who is ready to work.

Does The Vocation Depot have a specialty?

The Vocation Depot strives to help anyone ready to work, but we do have strong connections and resources for Veterans and current Service Members. The Vocation Depot is a Disabled Veteran Operated Entity, and we have been awarded the HireVets award by the Department of Labor. 
